## Born This Way

"If there is a God then He made me this way." Or "It's not my fault I have a fiery temper, I was born this way!" In effect we are trying to escape the responsibility of our sin either by denying it's very existence in us or putting the onus on God for it's presence. As Proverbs 16: 2 says:

"All the ways of a man are pure in his own eyes, but the Lord weighs the spirits."

The Bible teaches us something very different to the secular view. It teaches us that there definitely IS a God and He created us but did not create the sin in us. We were brought into existence for fellowship and spiritual unity with God but when mankind chose to rebel against Him, it resulted in spiritual death for us and subsequently created a spiritual void between God and man.
